This year, February 14th lands on a Saturday, so Valentine's Day dinners are likely to book up quickly. To make sure you don't get stuck with frozen pizza (and heartbreak), make your plans now.

[Bistro 110](#): Prices are still being finalized for the special menu at this Gold Coast French, but if you make reservations before February 11th, you'll be eligible to win a comped meal and an overnight stay at The Raffaello Hotel (312-266-3110).

[Blackbird](#): This West Loop New American will feature a seasonal six-course tasting menu (\$115 plus \$55 for wine tasting; 312-715-0708).

[Bristol](#): This Bucktown New American will be serving a three-course menu, including burrata cheese and caviar with preserved lemon, plus a selection of handmade truffles (\$39; 773-862-5555).

[C-House](#): Marcus Samuelsson's three-course menu offers fare like brioche-wrapped salmon, and dinner will be accompanied by the jazz stylings of the Josh Burke duo (\$50, includes a glass of sparkling wine; 312-523-0923).

[David Burke's Primehouse](#): Kobe beef sashimi is on the special four-course menu at this River North New American (\$75; 312-660-6000).

[Eve](#): The Gold Coast New American is offering a six-course prix fixe menu focusing on dishes like pheasant apricot terrine and maple-Brie grits (\$69; 312-266-3383).

[Le Colonial](#): Three courses of French-Vietnamese fare will be served at this Gold Coast romantic favorite (\$60; 312-255-0088).
